I was born in Milano, Italy, in 1978 and I received both my MS Degree in Engineering and my PhD in Physics from Politecnico di Milano, where I am currently Associate Professor. Before starting my professorship, I was a Humboldt Fellow at the University of Würzburg, Germany.
