The European Optical Society Oy protects the personal data of the participants, authors and other customers. All data is collected straight from conference participants, individual members, through each member society or corporate members of the EOS and the information is processed appropriately, transparently and according to the law. All information is collected, processed and stored confidentially and safely and used only for appropriate purposes. All data will be updated or cancelled when needed.

European Optical Society Oy will treat data provided by participants, authors and other customers confidentially and use them only in accordance with the provisions of the data protection law. Personal data are all data stored in connection with the name of the participants, authors and other customers. The basic data provided by the participant (title, first name, family name, delivery and invoice address, telephone and fax numbers, email address) is stored by European Optical Society Oy in an address data base as well as processed and used or – if necessary – forwarded to service providers appointed for the benefit of the members and invoicing. If consent is given, EOS will inform participants, authors and other customers of any relevant issues. Consent may be cancelled at any time by contacting the EOS office.
