The undersigned aware of the criminal sanctions, in the case of untruthful statements, training or use of false documents, referred to in art. 76 of the Presidential Decree 445 of 28 December 2000,

DECLARES

- 1) to have carefully read the documentation published at <https://www.uniroma1.it/it/node/229407>, concerning the correct behavior to be observed in the Sapienza offices for the purpose of preventing the spread of COVID-19 and undertake to implement all the recommendations and procedures indicated;
- 2) to have checked their body temperature today, before entering Sapienza, and to have found that it is below 37.5 C °
- 3) that you have no flu symptoms (cough, cold, sore throat, burning eyes, difficulty breathing).
- 4) I am not aware that I have been in close contact with any confirmed cases of COVID-19 in the last 14 days
- 5) not to be subject to a mandatory quarantine period in accordance with current government regulations
- 6) not to have tested positive for COVID-19, or to have tested positive but to possess suitable medical certification showing the "negativization occurred" in the manner provided, issued by the competent territorial Prevention Department or other competent health authority.

The undersigned undertakes to monitor the onset of symptoms while staying in the spaces of Sapienza, or contact situations with confirmed cases of COVID-19, and to promptly communicate such eventualities to their Sapienza contact person.

LEGAL BASIS OF THE PROCESSING

Art. 6 lett. e), of the European Regulation no. 679/2016: the execution of a task of public interest or connected to the exercise of public authority vested in the data controller

PURPOSE AND DESCRIPTION OF THE TREATMENT:

The data is processed, in compliance with the current regulatory framework, by the Employers, the Security Office and the Occupational Medicine Center in order to:

- protect the health and safety of workers in the workplace;
- keep under control the risk of spread of infectious diseases, and in particular of COVID-19;
- collect the information necessary for the management of COVID-19 risk in the workplace;
- transfer to the National Health Service, exclusively following a written request, any data relating to potential contacts at risk of contagion occurring in Sapienza.

The data will be used exclusively for the intended institutional purposes, within the scope of the provisions of laws, regulations or contractual rules.

NATURE OF THE PERSONAL DATA STRICTLY NECESSARY TO PURSUE THE PURPOSE DESCRIBED

Common personal: name, surname

Particular categories of personal data: data relating to health (body temperature, presence of flu symptoms, in particular, cough, cold, sore throat, burning eyes, difficulty in breathing).

ARCHIVING AND CONSERVATION

The data will be stored (in paper and digital format) for as long as necessary to achieve the aforementioned purposes, in accordance with national and European legislation (General (EU) Data Protection Regulation).

NOTES ON THE RIGHTS OF THE INTERESTED PARTY

We inform you that the interested party may ask the data controller, if the conditions apply, for access to personal data pursuant to art. 15 of the Regulations, the correction of the same pursuant to art. 16 of the Regulations, the cancellation of the same pursuant to art. 17 of the Regulation (if the latter does not conflict with the current legislation on the retention of the data and with the need to protect, in the event of a legal dispute, the University and the professionals who have processed them) or the limitation of processing pursuant to of the art. 18 of the Regulations, or may oppose their treatment pursuant to art. 21 of the Regulation, in addition to being able to exercise the right to data portability pursuant to art. 20 of the Regulation.

In case of violation of the provisions of the Regulations, the interested party may lodge a complaint with the Guarantor for the protection of personal data, in accordance with current legislation.
